Scholarship Application Rules

1. Applicants must be an inbound freshman for all Semester 2010 and a 2010 graduate of a public or private high school.
2. Applicant must respond to the questions below on standard paper. ALL RESPONSES MUST BE TYPED (hand printed and hand written responses will not be accepted).
3. Limit each response to no more than 400 words total. The response should be double spaced with a font of 12 or above. DO NOT USE NAMES OF PEOPLE OR SCHOOLS so as to maintain anonymity for evaluation.
4. Responses must be postmarked no later than April 30, 2010 and sent to:

5. Scholarship recipient(s) will be selected and notified by May 7, 2010.
